**4 TO 6 MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY CONFORMATION–AM SHOWS**

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Class is not divided by sex.

**NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE Dog Entries**

**Stud Dog:** For Stud Dogs and at least two of their Get, Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud dog class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. The owner of the Stud dog need not necessarily be the owner of the Get. Get must be entered in a regular or non-regular class. Get only to be judged, based on the merit of the Get.

**Brood Bitch:** Same as for Stud dog class except substitute Brood bitch for Stud dog and Produce for Get.

**\*\*BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR (BBE) CLASS ELIGIBILITY (Revised 9/2002)**

All dogs entered in the Bred-By-Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the AKC. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record and owner of record of the dog. To exhibit in this class, family members must be breeder and owner of Record.

**NOHS ELIGIBILITY**

Professional handler, household members and current assistants to professional handlers in conformation are not eligible to exhibit in this competition. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the Cluster/ weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

Professional handler is defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers’ organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.

Dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for the AKC NOHS throughout the breed level (all classes, Winners, and Best of Breed) competition. Additionally, dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for all AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition (Group and Best in Show). Any person may exhibit the dog in the regular Group and Best in Show competitions.

Eligibility restrictions apply to all members of the same household.

### **JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION**

AKC Junior Handler Numbers are now required for entry in Junior Showmanship Competition. Numbers may be obtained from the American Kennel Club, Phone: 919-233-9767. For additional information, contact American Kennel Club, Junior Showmanship, PO Box 900051, Raleigh, NC 27675. Phone: 919-233-9767 or Email: juniors@akc.org. Entry blank MUST be filled out with necessary information, otherwise the entry in Junior Showmanship will not be accepted.

**NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**NOVICE SENIOR CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN JUNIOR CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places with competition present, in a Novice Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

**NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places with competition present in a Novice Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

**NOVICE SENIOR CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places with competition present in a Novice Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

**MASTER CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 First Place wins in an Open Class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC Eukanuba National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

8. The ready ring will also be expanded to accommodate social distancing. Only one class at a time will be allowed in the ready ring. Once that class has entered the show ring, the next class in may enter the ready ring. This will be strictly adhered to.
9. Exhibitors will be asked to show the bite of their dog.
10. There will be two openings to the show ring; one for an entrance coming in and one for an exit going out. Please adhere to this.

**CLOSING DATE** for entries 5:00 PM, Wednesday, April 21, 2021 (at Show Secretary's Office) after which entries cannot be accepted, canceled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules.

**A RECORDING FEE** of \$ .50 and an **AKC EVENT SERVICE FEE** of \$3.00 will be required for each Dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. These Fees are to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a Dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Fees are to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2).

**ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS AND PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form and NOT acceptable.**

**ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES** will not be accepted.

**ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRIES** will be made as soon as practicable. SHOULD SUCH ACKNOWLEDGMENT NOT BE RECEIVED BY THE EXHIBITOR within a reasonable time, notify LYDIA STRAUSS, Show Sect., 917-941-2223.

**ENTRY FEES** shall not be refunded in the event that a Dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from Competition by action of Show Committee. If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the Management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

**ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS.** Owners are responsible for any errors made on entry forms. No entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or of the cancellation of entries after the published closing.

**NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES.** We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if a Dog has been processed, no refund will be made.

**DO NOT ATTEMPT TO COME IN FROM RT. 22 !!**

**From South via NJ Turnpike** – Take Tpk. North to **Exit 10** and follow signs for I-287 North. Follow I-287 N to Exit 14B for Route 22 West. Go west 2.5 miles to exit for Route 202 / 206 South. Follow signs for Route 202 South -Flemington, which takes you over the Somerville traffic circle. About 2 miles past circle after you go under a RR bridge turn right onto Milltown Road. North Branch Park is about 0.4 miles up road on your left.
